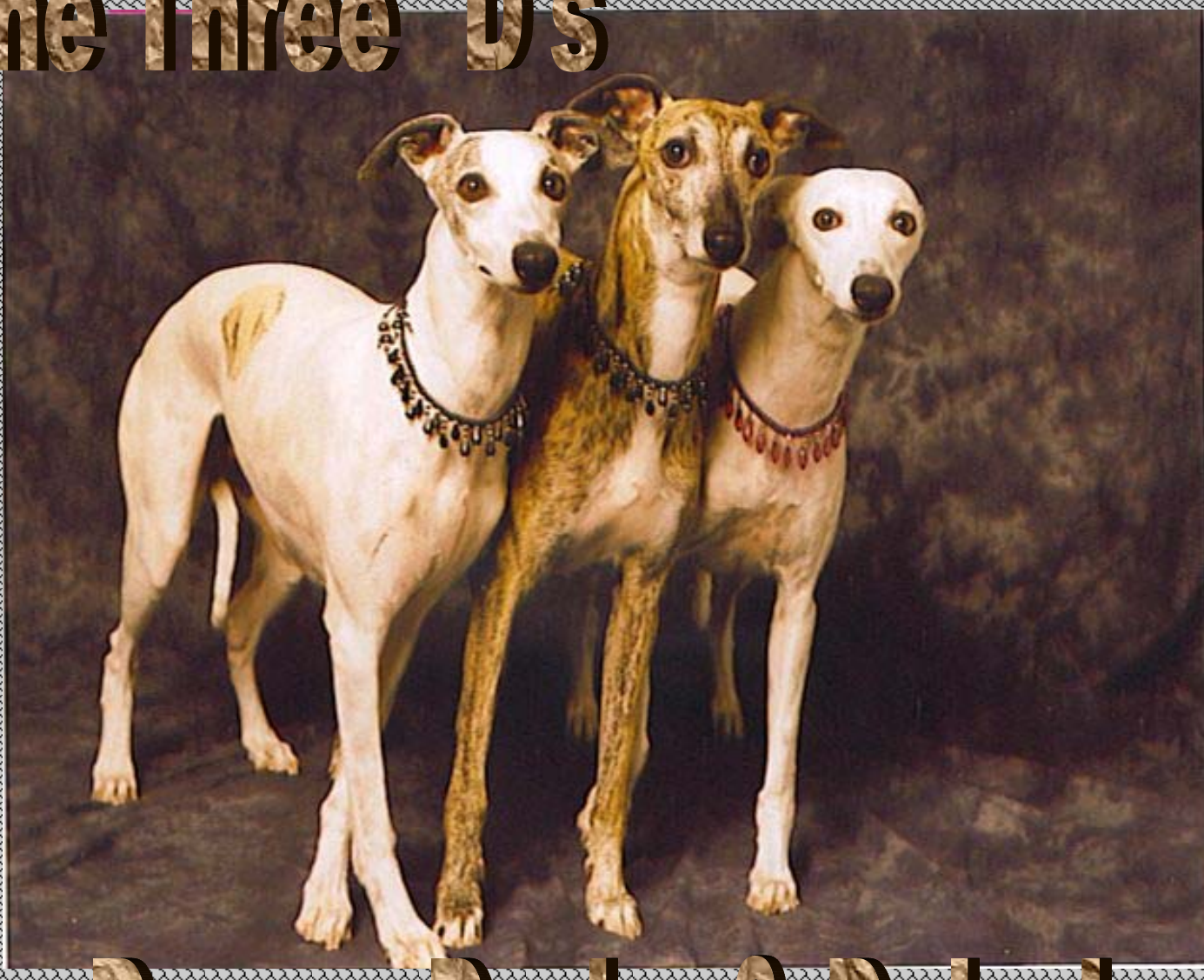

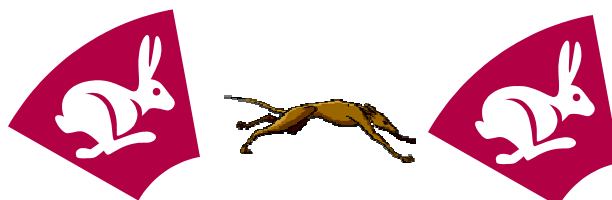

## Current Rescue: “FLOYD”

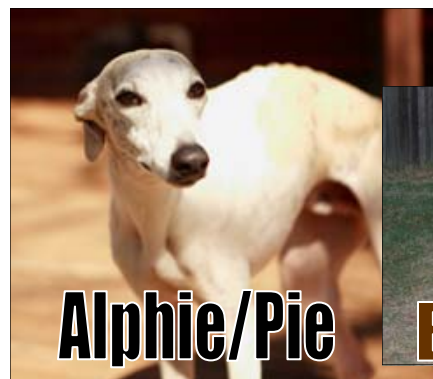
