PRE-ENTRY FEE: \$ 20 per test entry. Late/Day-of entry: \$30

LIMITED ENTRY – 65 ENTRIES PER TEST

Late and day-of event entries will be accepted until roll call for each test if the entry limit for a test has not been met.

NOTE: 2 separate tests are being offered, with the second test starting 15 minutes after the conclusion of the first test. You may use a single entry form to enter 1 or both tests for a dog by marking the boxes for the tests you wish to enter on the form. Each test requires a separate entry fee. The attached entry form can be filled out on-line prior to printing it. Please indicate the size of the dog on the entry form.

NOTE: While the track has fencing/buildings on each side, it is not completely fenced. Please be sure your dog can be caught at the end of the race.

TEST OFFERED: FAST CAT TEST

FAST CAT Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.) **GO TO AKC.org TO REGISTER A CANINE COMPANION.**

The **FAST Cat** test is a timed 100 yard dash. The dog is released at the starting line by one person and then must be caught by a second person at the finish line. If you are entering more than one dog, please indicate whether you prefer your dogs to run one after the other (you must have slippers and catchers to allow this) or would like to have them separated with several other dogs between them. **If you wish them separated, please mark the box "Please separate my entries" on the entry form.**

TRIAL HOURS: 8 AM until completion of second test

ROLL CALL: TEST 1 – 9:00 AM; TEST 2 – 15 Minutes after completion of Test 1.

Inspection starts 1 hour prior to roll call for the first test. Dogs entered only in the second test may check in at any time prior to or at roll call for the second test. Racing for the first test will start as soon as dogs are checked in. Racing for the second test will start 15 minutes after the conclusion of the first test. **After entries close, entrants will be notified by email of entry receipt/acceptance, entry totals for each test, roll call times if entries are large.**

Please be sure your email address is clear on your entry.

The parking lot nearest the field has solar panels, providing plenty of shade for parking.

FAST CAT tests are divided into 3 categories dependent on the size of the dog. The size category is used in the calculation to determine how many points are awarded towards AKC FAST CAT titles based on the Mile Per Hour (MPH) of the dog's dash. Please indicate on your entry form if the entry is less than 12 inches, 12 inches but less than 18 inches, or 18 inches or over. If the height is questionable the inspection committee will measure dog to be sure.

These tests will be conducted with manual timing. A battery powered continuous loop system will be used with white or colored plastic streamers for the lure. Back-up equipment will be available.

DIRECTIONS: From the East on I-80 exit Suisun Valley Road, veer right on to Suisun Valley Road. The college is on the right in approximately one mile. Do not turn in at the first entrance; turn in the second entrance where the right lane ends. Stay to the left to the back of the college. The track is behind the parking lot with the solar panels, which provide plenty of shade for parking. **From the West on I-80** Exit Suisun Valley Road. Go Left on to Suisun Valley Road. Continue as above.
