REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Coursing, ASFA Field Champion title, ASFA Pre-Cert, or CKC Field Champion title. Hounds that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA, or CKC field trials may not be entered.
OPEN VETERANS: Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter open or specials stake and meet the age requirement for veteran, as established by their breed club.
SPECIALS: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Champion title.
SINGLE: Open to all hounds, including those disqualified to run in other stakes.

NON REGULAR STAKE OFFERED

BREEDER STAKE: For two whippets, entered in the open, open veteran or special stake, that have at least one breeder in common. Please check the box for Breeder Stake on the entry form & fill out & include the Breeder Stake entry form at the end of this premium list with your regular entries. Breeder Stake entry fee is \$10 per group. Winner of the Breeder Stake to be determined by the highest combined score from among the entered pairs.

Qualified Course Handlers: Please make arrangements to have a test dog for your QC. Test dog will be required to fill out an entry form.

Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and entry fees refunded. Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines, and white plastic lure will be used. Backup equipment will be available. The Field Committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the trial site. NCWFA reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test. **A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.**

1. All lure trial committee members & participants will wear facial coverings at all times during the event.
2. Upon arrival, all participants must proceed to the check-in station, where their temperature[s] will be checked, the CDC COVID-19 Screening Questions will be asked, it will be confirmed that we have received entry fee payment & a signed rule agreement/waiver will be collected from each person. Temperature shall be taken with a touchless thermometer & any participant with a temperature of over 100.4 will have their entries rejected & will be asked to leave. Any participant who answers "yes" to any of the CDC screening questions will be asked to leave. Each participant will be issued a wristband upon successful check-in.
3. No food will be served. Bring your own water & shade, for yourself and your dogs. None will be available at this time.
4. We ask that you park & set up camp at a safe distance from one another.
5. When standing in line to check-in & when in the paddock before your course, please maintain a safe distance from the persons ahead & behind you. When your course is called to the line, entrants will proceed to the start & maintain a safe distance from one another. When picking up dogs upon completion of the course, catch your dog & proceed off the field. Masks will be worn at all times when on the field or in the parking area.
6. Observe social distancing while waiting to run, at the line & when retrieving hounds at the finish.
7. NCWFA members, wearing NCWFA logo tees, will be monitoring for compliance with all above social distancing & masking requirements. Anyone not complying with the above requirements will be immediately asked to leave the college & may be subject to disciplinary action, up to or including a bench hearing or expulsion from the Club.
