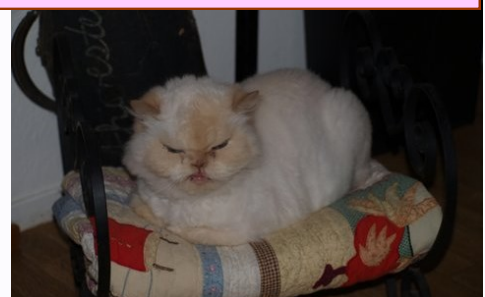
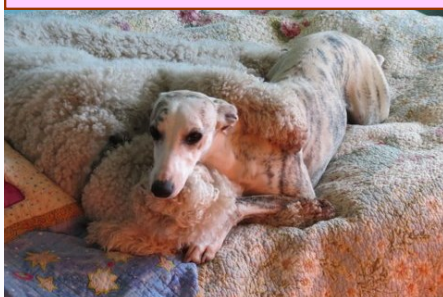

The 2015 NCWFA Baby Boom continues.

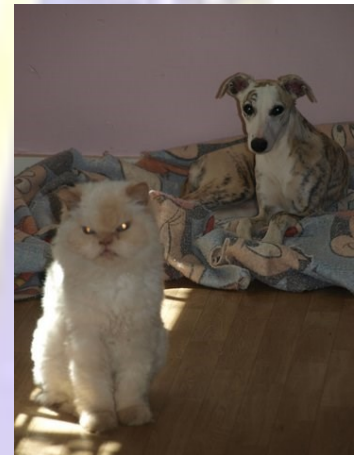

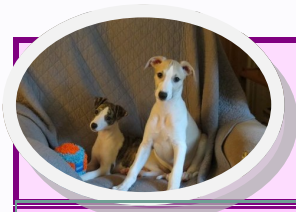
Natasha (Brad Briscoe) will obviously be gracing us with MANY puppies at the end of May. Poor girl is h-u-g-e!

Speed: Guin reported that covers are available for several issues of SPEED. Please let her know if you would like to reserve a cover.

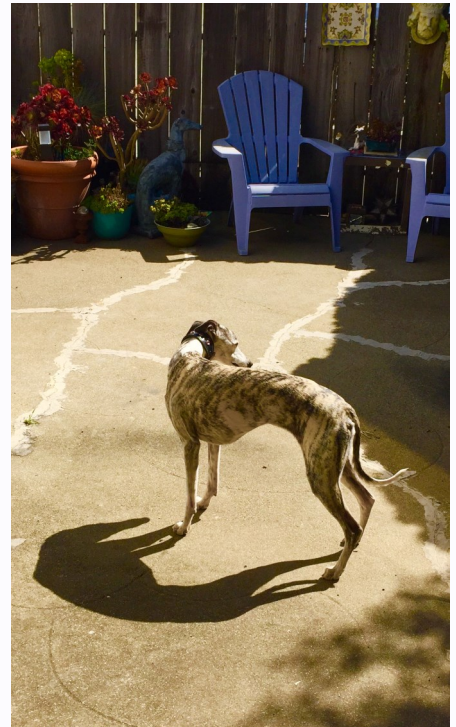
Website: No report.

Braggs commenced and the meeting was adjourned at 11:20 AM.

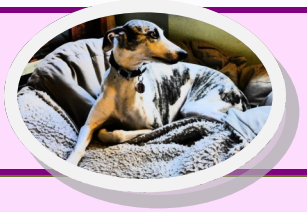

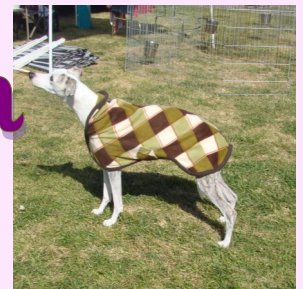
