




NCWFA Membership **Meeting**, Oakland, 12/6/09

The meeting was called to order at 3:15 PM. The minutes of the last two meetings were approved as published in SPEED, with the notation that 2nd VP, Mary Jean Odron was left off of the Officer's Slate.

Officer Reports

President's Report: Brad thanked all members for their great teamwork in 2009. He thanked Lenore for sharing her home once again for the Party and she received a round of applause.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Linda reported that the balance was \$18008.88 as of 12/5, with several expenses outstanding.

Committee Reports

Coursing: Russell reported that the net profit of the November lure trials was approximately \$1800, with gross revenue being \$4300. Discussion ensued regarding supplies that may help with future trials, including a computer and printer, sturdier score posting area, and better potluck organization. These items will be discussed at future meetings. Discussion was raised by Debby as to the possibility of subsidizing accommodations for the workers coming from a great distance. This idea was tabled, however Guin will look into procuring a group rate at the host motel for 2010 to offset staff expenses.

Racing: Jean announced a date change for 2010 to the first weekend of June. She has figured out a way to host race practices at Solano without incurring increased insurance fees, so this option will be pursued in 2010. The members present approved a donation to RCRA race meet to be held with the 2010 National.

This petite guy, who measures just 19 inches at the shoulder and weighs in at 22 pounds, should be ready for his forever home very soon. He's looking for an active home, willing to continue his training, with other dogs, no cats, and fun people.

The NCWFA Rescue Team is also expecting at least two new rescue guys to come into the system in January, so any help with foster homes, home checks and transport will be appreciated. For some reason, early spring is always a busy time for Rescue!

THE RESCUE YEAR IN REVIEW 2009

<u>January:</u> The year began with me at the SF airport on the second, picking up our first rescue of 2009, Patch. Patch found his forever home with failed foster mother, NCWFA member Helen Hultman



Also in January, we assisted in the private placement of Jamie, a cat-crazy whippet guy

from Davis who was one step away from eating his own house cat. Jamie now lives in San Jose, with the Hooks, who have no kitties, but lots of kids in and out (Karen is a music therapist for autistic children), and love this cute guy to pieces!
