# 2012 Specialty Judge Candidate Bios

Biographies for the 2012 NCWFA Specialty & Sweepstakes Judging Candidates are presented below, in order to assist members in their voting. Voting for the 2012 panel will be held this year at our JUNE MEETING (Saturday, June 11th). This is a change from the last few years. The BOD decided to move the voting to June in order to take advantage of hopefully cooler weather and thus a larger turnout for voting. Please note that there will be two ballots for Sweepstakes judges, one for the Specialty and one for Del Valle.

## REGULAR CLASS JUDGING CANDIDATES

Mr. Bo Bengtson: Mr. Bengtson has been involved in whippets since 1961, first in Sweden and, since 1980, in the US. His Bohem whippets have been influential sires and brood bitches, top show winners, and he's even bred a DC or two. Mr. Bengtson is also well known as the founder and current editor-at-large of the Sighthound Review and of Dogs in Review magazines. Bengtson has judged the AWC National in 2006, as well as other regional specialties, and many special whippet entries, including Westminster & Crufts. His book The Whippet was published in its third, enlarged edition in 2010 He is approved by the AKC to judge whippets and all sighthounds, as well as dachshunds and golden retrievers. Mr. Bengtson lives in Ojai, CA.

Ms. Katrina Hamilton: Ms. Hamilton has been involved with whippets since she was a child. Under the kennel prefix "Khiva", she, along with her sister and mother, have bred champion whippets, as well as salukis, for over 40 years. Katrina was also a successful handler of the sighthound breeds. Ms. Hamilton is approved by the AKC to judge whippets, salukis and junior

showmanship. Past large assignments have been the AWC Western in 2001, and supported entries in MA and TN in the mid-2000s, all with above average entries. Katrina resides in Murfeesboro, TN.

Mrs. Leslie Hiltz: Mrs. Hiltz started showing her original breed, beagles, in 1967 in Australia. She moved to the US in 1988 and merged her successful kennel with that of her husband, David, and the Starbuck-Torbay Beagles were born. Her involvement with whippets began at this time and she has owned and shown several top winning whippets over the years, some in the US, and a few in Australia. Mrs. Hiltz is approved by the AKC to judge the Hound, Herding, Non-Sporting & Toy groups, as well as 11 Working breeds. She has judged supported entries in WI, IA, southern CA, and SC, but this would be her first whippet specialty assignment. Mrs. Hiltz resides in Brush Prairie WA.

Mrs. Jamie Souza-Bartlett: Mrs. Bartlett grew up with sighthounds, since her mother and grandmother have the successful "Limerick" Irish Wolfhounds. Jamie started with a Crestfield whippet as a junior showman in 1985 and has been exhibiting and breeding whippets ever since. Mrs. Bartlett was and is a very successful owner-breeder-handler of IWs, whippets, salukis and other breeds. Jamie is approved by the AKC to judge whippets, Irish Wolfhounds, and junior showmanship. A newer judge, Jamie has done large supported entries in WI and VA, as well as the SCWA Specialty in 2010. She resides in San Francisco, CA.

## SWEEPSTAKES JUDGING CANDIDATES

Mr. David Barrett: Mr. Barrett has had whippets since the early 1980s. He has been a successful exhibitor and breeder under the Adahvi prefix. Mr. Barrett is now well known as an award-winning photographer. He resides in Portland, OR.

Mrs. Jean Balint: (Del Valle only) Mrs. Balint has had whippets since the 1960s, and since that date her Wyndsor's have been known as top race dogs, winning show and lure coursing competitors, and obedience titleists. Jean has judged numerous sweepstakes/futurities at both the regional and national level. Mrs. Balint lives in Fairfield, CA.

Mrs. Linda Buchholtz: (Specialty only) Mrs. Buchholtz started in whippets as a teenager. Since the late 1960s, her Swiftsure whippets have had success as racers, coursers, and top show winners, both in the US and Canada. Linda has judged many sweepstakes both here and north of the border. Mrs. Buchholtz lives in Vancouver, BC, Canada.

Ms. Kathy Thomas: Ms. Thomas has been involved in the breed since her teen years in the 1970s, first with ARM racing and more recently as a successful breeder and exhibitor, along with her sister and mother, of the Watch Me Whippets. Ms. Thomas judged the Hound Show sweepstakes with Palm Springs in 2010. Kathy resides in Las Vegas, NV.




