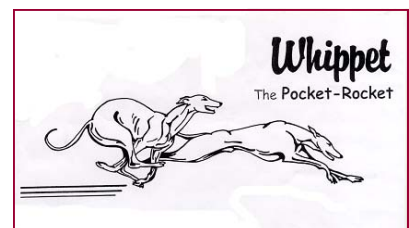

Exciting times continue for NCWFA Rescue!

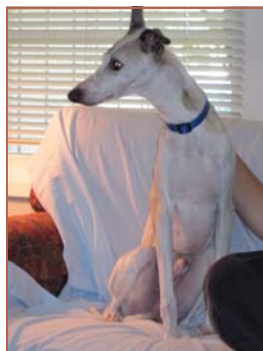
Current Rescues - *Scottie!*

Rescue Roo-Roos go out to Frank & Sallie Richards who made a nice donation in memory of Pepper, Peet & Rosie.

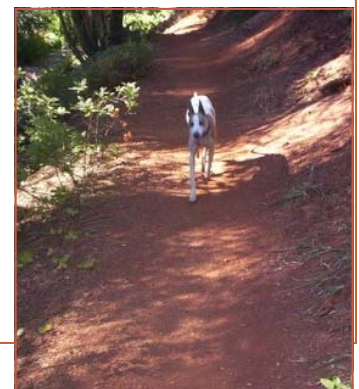
We also received a nice note and the photo below from member Betty Stites, who adopted Harry Potter:

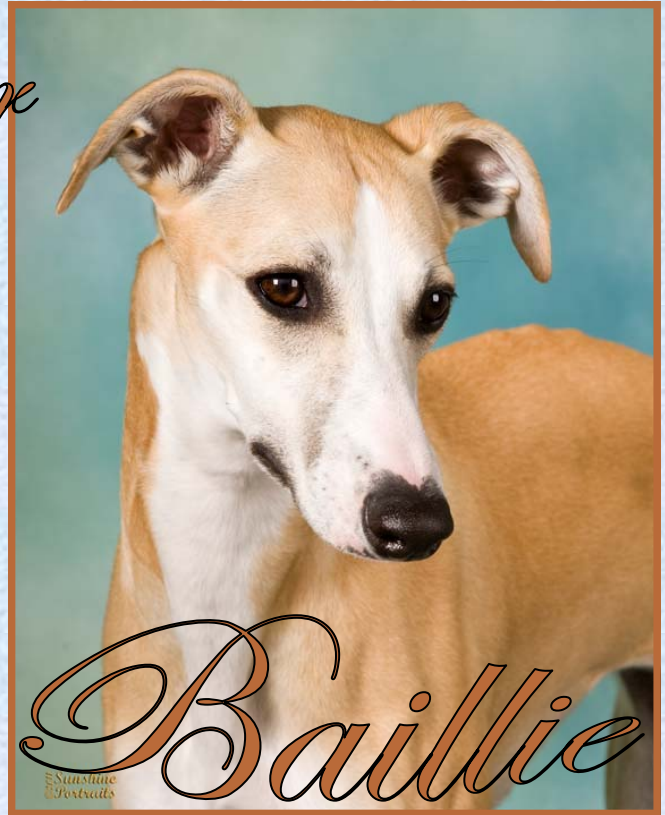
